Learning outcomes

How can people protect their money?



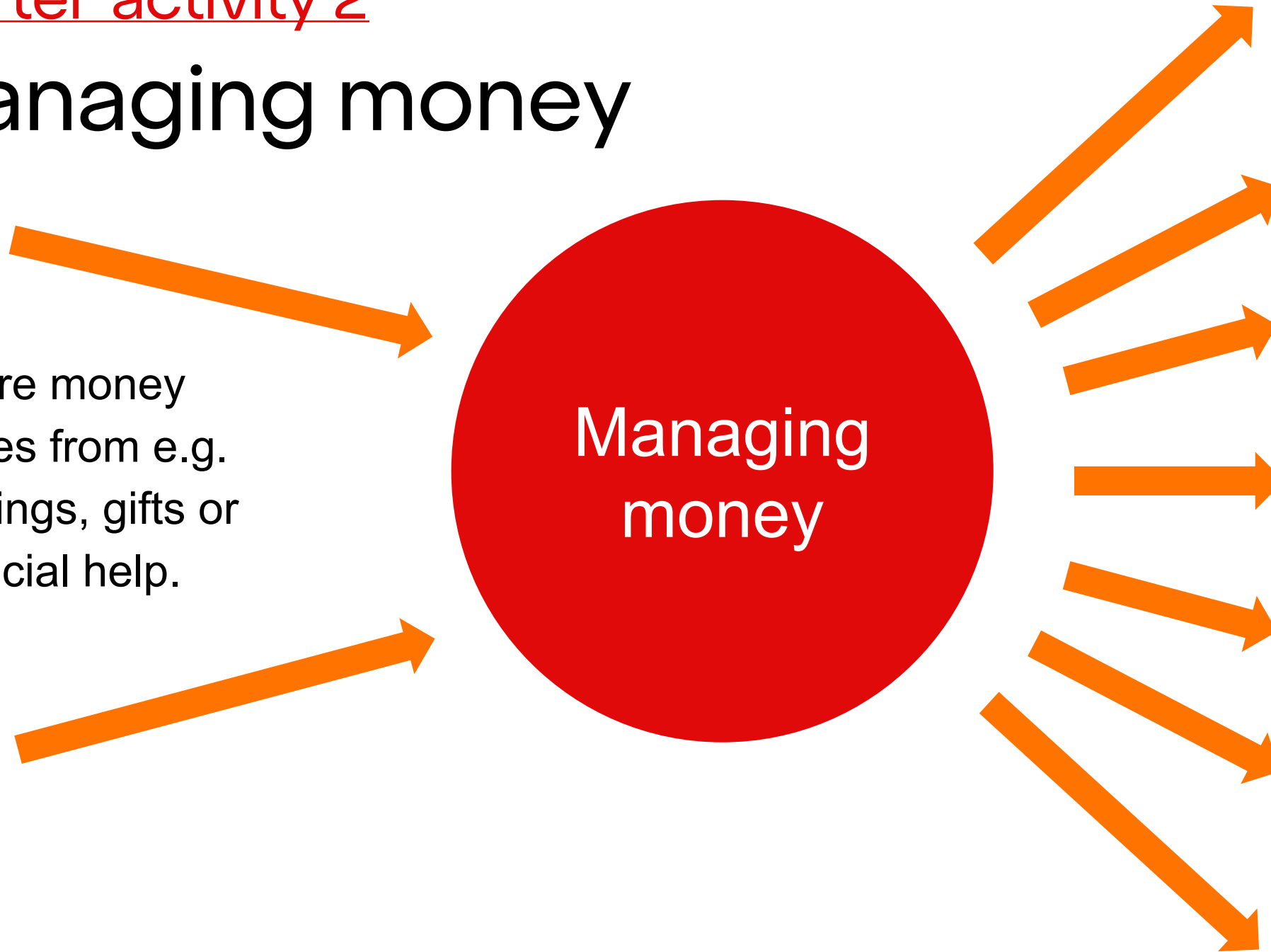
Starter activity 2

Where money comes from e.g. earnings, gifts or financial help.

Where money goes e.g. rent, food, clothing...



Main activity 1

Play the pocket money game!

How to play

- Start with £5 pocket money
- Roll a dice to move
 - Sometimes you **HAVE** to pay or save
 - Sometimes you can **CHOOSE**
- Add up how your money goes up and down
- When you land on **START** again, you get £5 pocket money
- If you run out of money, transfer money back out of your savings or keep rolling until you get back to **START** (but you can't buy or save until then)

Money, choices and feelings

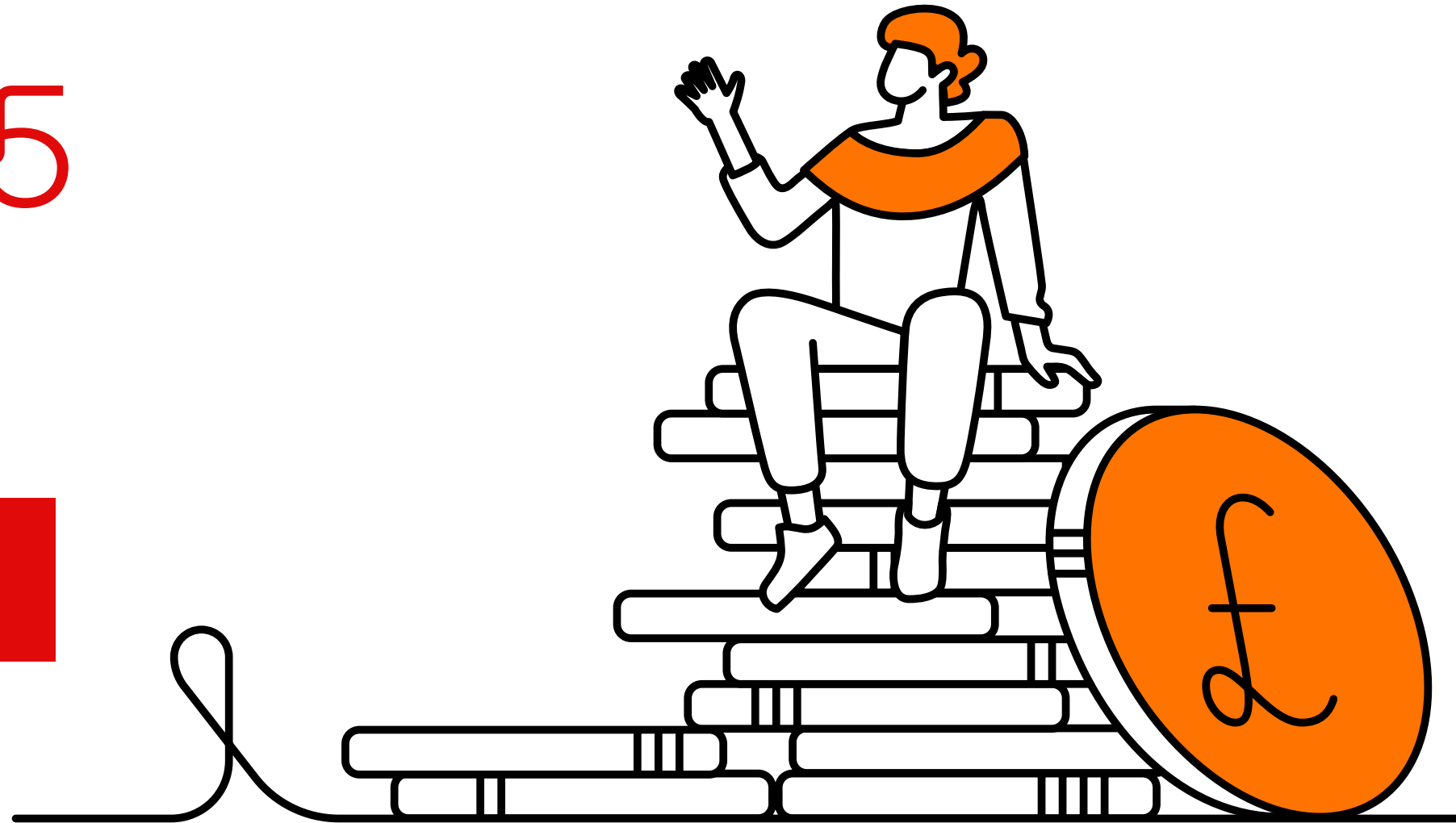
