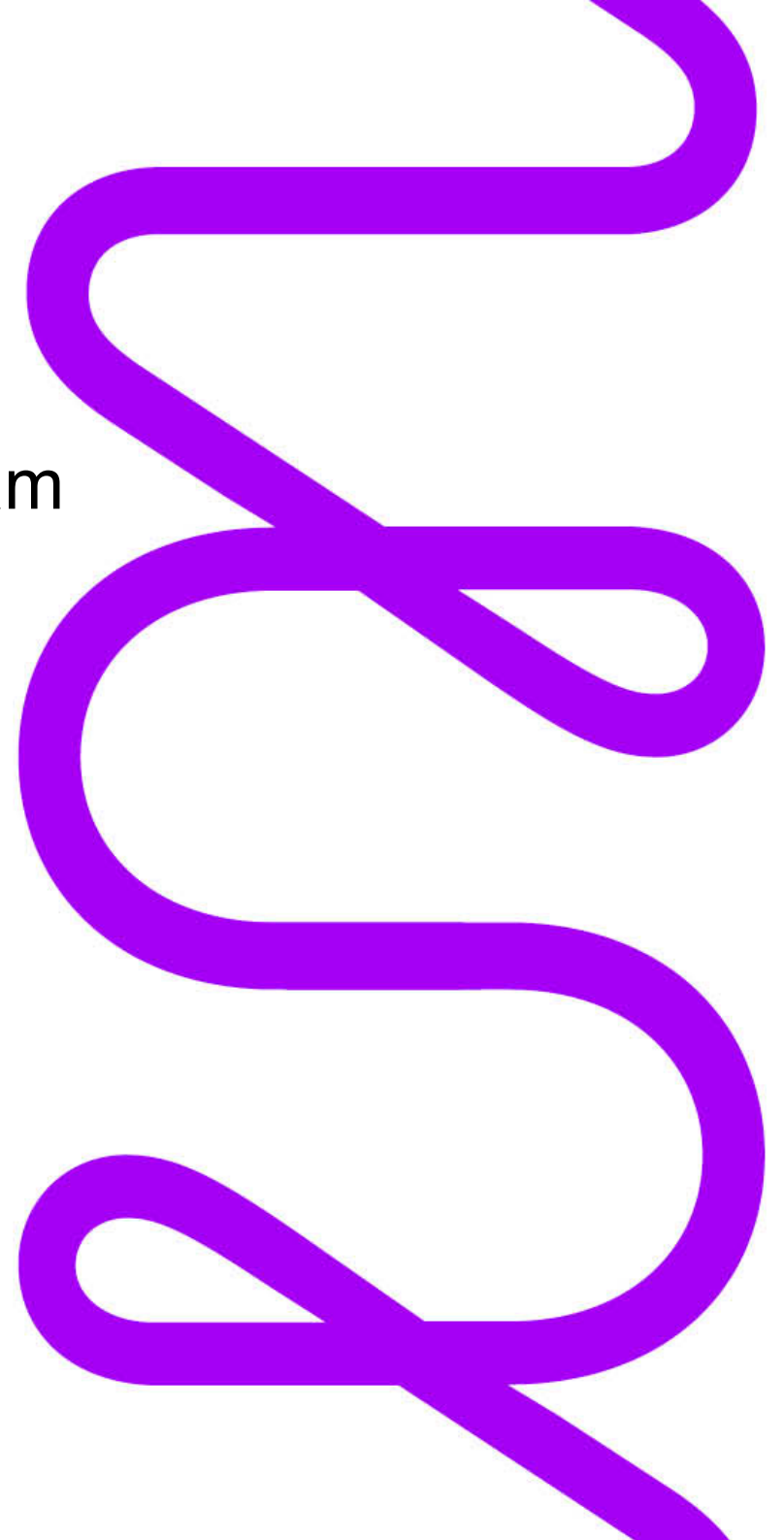
Learning outcomes

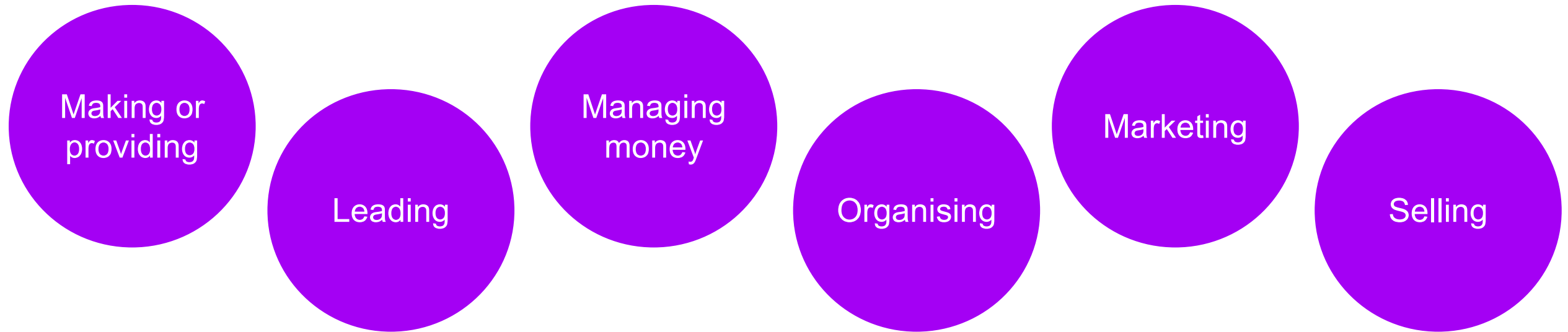
Roles and responsibilities
