- Play the pocket money game to learn about spending and saving money



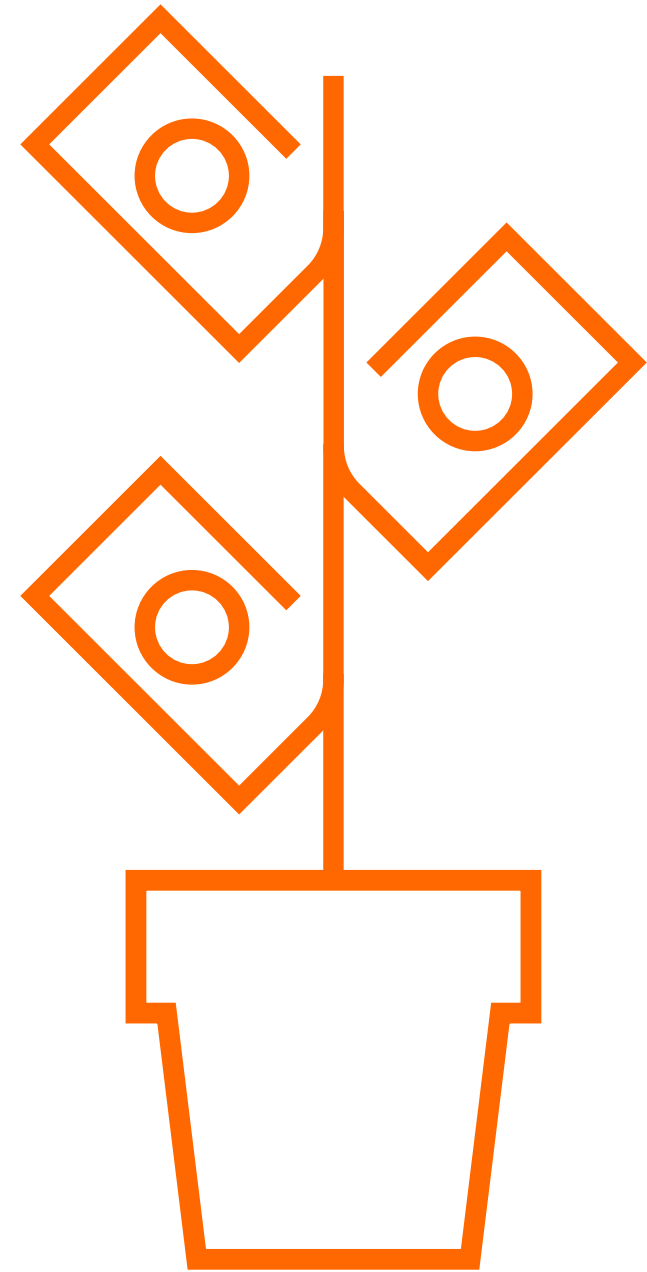

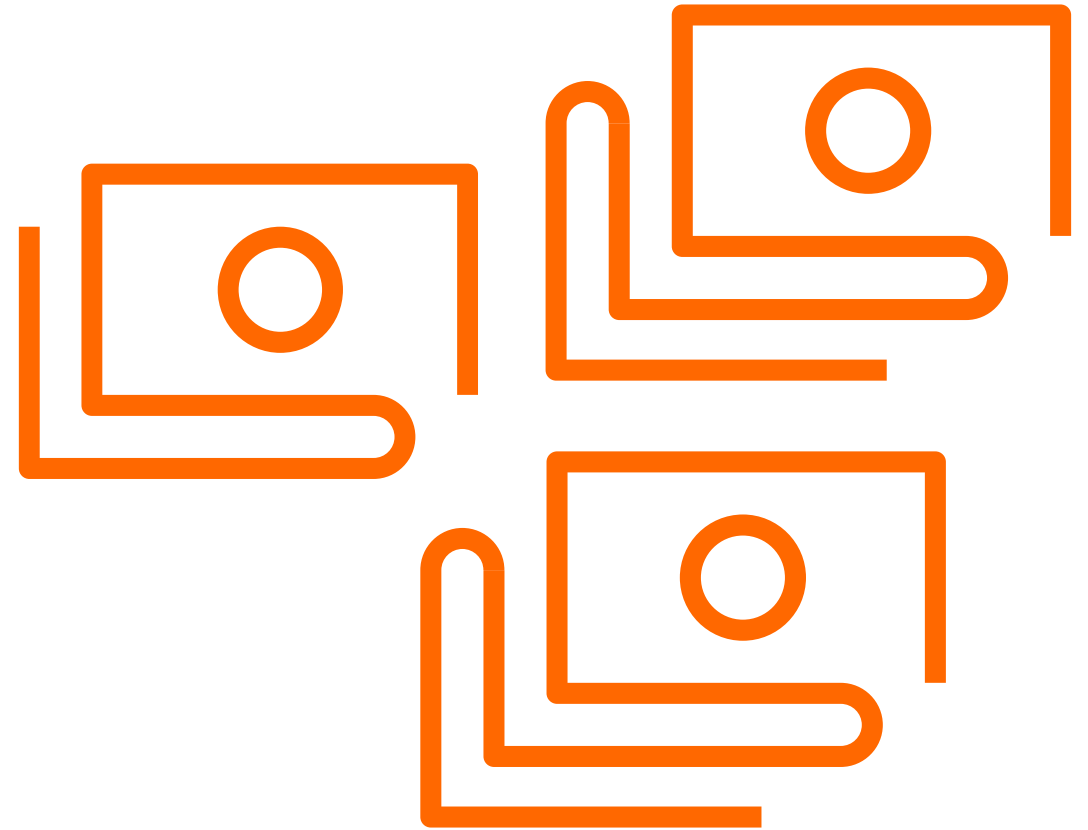

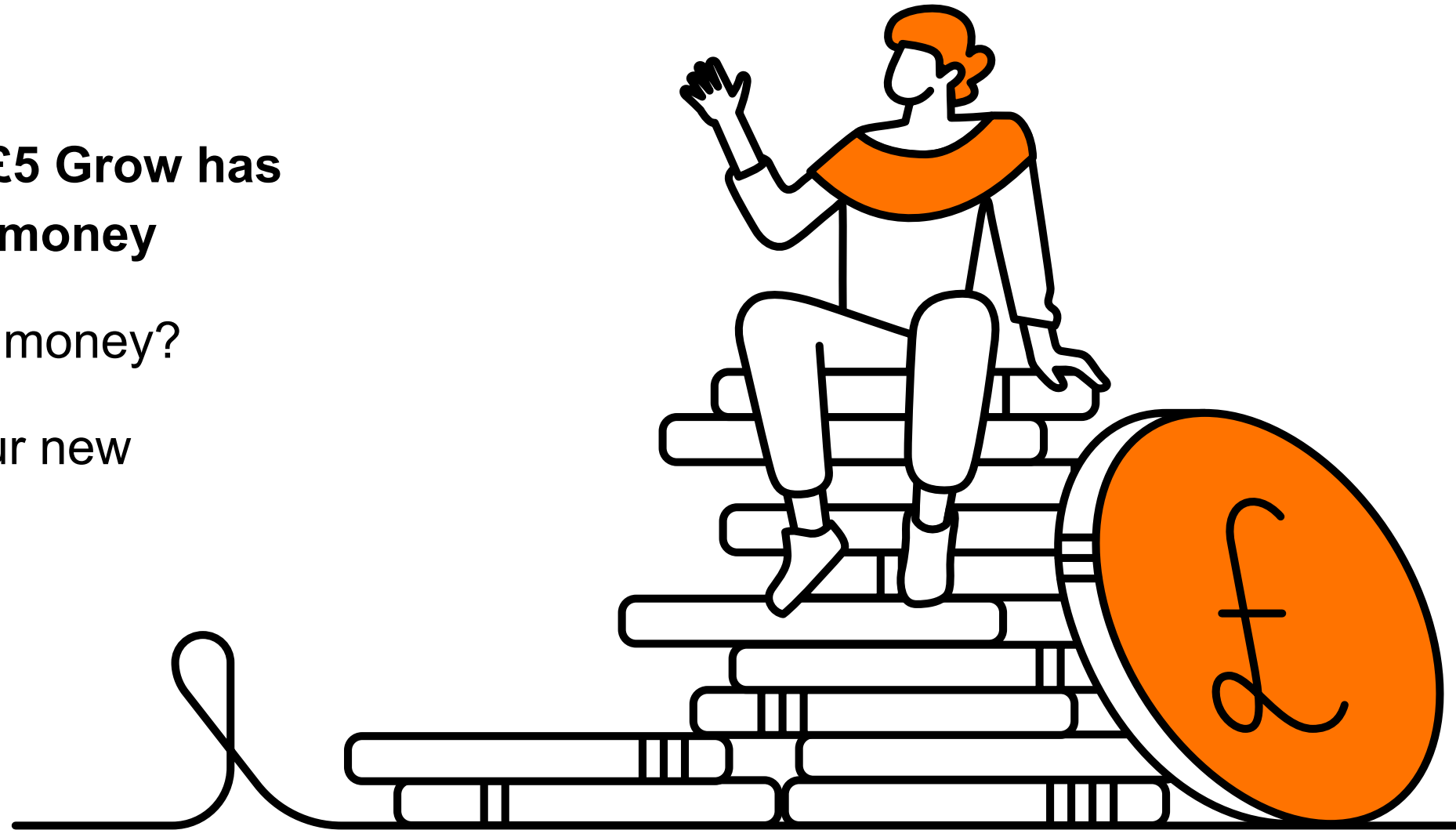
